When To Refer for Mental Health Services

The following reactions, behaviors, and symptoms may signal a need to consult with the appropriate professional for further assistance.

- Disorientation - dazed, memory loss, inability to give date or time, state where he or she is, recall events of the past 24 hours or understand what is happening.
- Mental Illness - hearing voices, seeing visions, delusional thinking, excessive preoccupation with an idea or thought, pronounced pressure of speech (e.g., talking rapidly with limited content continuity).
- Inability to care for self - not eating, bathing or changing clothes, inability to manage activities of daily living.
- Suicidal or homicidal thoughts or plans.
- Problematic use of alcohol or drugs.
- Domestic violence, child abuse or elder abuse.

Recognizing Suspected Abuse of Adults

Watch for:

- Unexplained injuries such as burns, fractures and bruises, or
- Poor hygiene and/or grooming.
- Someone who seems depressed, anxious, and afraid, who may refuse to talk or answer questions.
- Someone who is rarely outside the house or at church/community functions.
- Not allowed to speak on their own behalf.
- Dehydration or lack of food (thin, listless, pale, tired).
- Unpaid bills or an unexplained loss of money/valuables.
- Someone who resists medical treatment.

Children suspected of being physically abused may display:

- A poor self-image.
- Inability to depend on, trust or love others.
- Aggressive and disruptive — sometimes illegal — behavior.
- Passive and withdrawn behavior, fear of entering into new relationships or activities.
- School failure.
- Serious drug and alcohol abuse.

There are several options in Pennsylvania for FREE or LOW-COST health insurance coverage for children. The programs currently available in western Pennsylvania are:

BlueCHIP of Pennsylvania; a state-supported health care program which is administered by the Western Pennsylvania Caring Foundation, Inc., in the Western Pennsylvania region. Blue Cross and Blue Shield benefits are provided to eligible children who meet age and income requirements.

Caring Program for Children: a program of Blue Cross of Western Pennsylvania and Pennsylvania Blue Shield for children who meet established income guidelines. Free, low-cost direct pay. No preexisting condition clause.

BlueCHIP of Pennsylvania and the Caring Program for Children will enroll a child without regard to the child's health. A preexisting illness will NOT disqualify a child for either program.

Blue Cross and Blue Shield Special Care has been designed especially for individuals and families who do not receive insurance coverage from their employers. Often, these are people whose income is too high to qualify for state Medical Assistance (Medicaid), but too low to afford traditional private health insurance. If you meet the income and other guidelines and complete the enrollment requirements, you will be eligible to enroll in the low cost Special Care Program.
