Motion to modify the FY 2008 Mercer County Community Development Block Grant by transferring \$38,132.55 from the Water and Storm Water Improvements line items to the Housing Rehabilitation and Senior Center/Facilities Improvements line items. Jackson Twp Housing Rehab will receive \$17,132.55; McQuiston Center in Sandy Lake will receive \$21,000.00.

Motion to accept the bid and enter into a contract with Northeastern Mowing Service of Poland, Ohio for the maintenance mowing and lime application of the seven County owned dams. The contract calls for each dam to be mowed once in the spring and once in the fall annually with one application of lime for a three year term. The cost per mowing is \$7,410.00 times six mowings and \$12,200.00 for the lime application for a total of \$56,660.00.

Work will include construction of a new access road from SR 58 and rehabilitation of the existing lane, construction of pedestrian trails, site grading, storm water drainage, and culvert installation. A grant from PA Dept of Conservation and Natural Resources will cover 50% of the cost. County matching funds will be provided by the Mercer County Conservation District through the Dirt and Gravel Roads Program, and Munnell Run Farm Foundation. County match will include in-kind work of existing County Conservation District staff.
