SEWAGE FACILITIES PROJECT

The preconstruction job conference for the Sewage Facilities Project was conducted on 7/22/15 at 9:00 AM at the Mercer County Courthouse. A notice-to-proceed was issued for 8/3/15. The first project meetings are scheduled to begin at 9:00 AM on 8/27/15 at the Mercer County Courthouse.

Contract No. 1: Klinginsmith Enterprises began work on 8/3/15 along Butler Pike working toward Schaffer Rd. and Thompson Rd.

Contract No. 2: J.S. Bova Excavating began work on 8/4/15 along Wright St. Work will progress toward Court st. and then onto Lamor Rd. A second crew will begin on Autumn Dr.

Contract No. 3: 200 grinder pump units were ordered from Trombold Equipment. 100 will be delivered to the County property at the Interchange and 100 will be delivered to an address along the Mercer-Pulaski Rd. Approximately 100 grinder pump units were delivered to Mortimer's storage site located on the Mercer County Property along State Rt. 19 on 8/10/15.

Contract No. 4: On 8/7/15, Mortimer's Excavating began meeting with property owners in order to determine the property owner's desired location of the individual grinder pump unit that is to be installed on their property. Dan provided a copy of the "door hanger" that Mortimer is using in the event that no one is available at the property at the time that Mortimer is there to perform this investigation.

Contract No. 7: Jack Gibson Construction began mobilizing and installing the access roads for the Sewage Treatment Plant and the Interchange Pump Station on 8/7/15.

The project milestone schedule has been updated and is attached to the Engineer's Report.

We received (1) new grinder pump installation agreement. The updated grinder pump agreement status report is attached to the Engineer's Report.

On 8/4/15, the Authority received correspondence from USDA rural Development regarding the content required in the Authority's monthly report to USDA. The Authority should discuss the logistics of the preparation of this monthly report.
