Motion to apply for a flood mitigation grant of \$114,951.25 from the Commonwealth Financing Authority of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to be used to evaluate and repair seven earthen flood control dams owned by the County. Although annually maintained by the County, annual inspections have identified areas requiring rehabilitation. Scope of work: correct erosion areas, revegetate, provide scour protection for spillways, remove debris to maintain dam capacity, and install additional fencing to prevent unauthorized access and reduce future damage. The total project cost of \$140,211.25 would be funded by this grant request of \$114,951.25, county match of \$21,300.00, and additional county cost for non-eligible costs of \$3,960.00. All county costs have been included in our 2017 capital and operating budgets.
