General Discussion Items:

Presentation of Proclamation on Mental Health Response, Call to Action, previously adopted on 12/21/2017 and presented this day to Mark Benedetto (Chief Juvenile Probation Officer), Dan Pustinger (State Parole) and Laura Leskovac (CJAB Coordinator). Commissioner Boyd recounted the early adoption of Mercer County's involvement and commitment with the Stepping Up initiative and lauded our success to date with drug, alcohol and mental illness awareness, training and implementation programs.

Benedetto commented that Pustinger and Leskovac attended the Stepping Up conference in December and that the Proclamation may permit application for grant funds. Pustinger stated that as of April, 2017, Pennsylvania is the third state to adopt a statewide initiative for Stepping Up and Mercer County is the 20th county in the state to pass a Proclamation. CJAB mapping of the intercept model has helped to reduce mental illness inmates in our jail since 2015. Per Leskovac, Mercer County has a strategic framework to address mental illness and that fifteen people have completed the Crisis Intervention Team Training program that shall continue in 2018.

Greenburg commented that new re-districting maps are to be issued by 2/19/2018 by the courts, if not issued prior by the General Assembly/Governor. The new maps should not affect Mercer County voters. Elections Office is due to sign off with their vendor for ballot preparation by the end of March. Mercer County should be prepared for the May 15th election.

Elder commented that four bridge construction projects of less than 20 feet in length are due to commence mid-April.

Commissioner McConnell commented that Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is considering five projects and that approximately \$1.6MM is available over a multi-year period to fund these projects. Elder commented that all the projects are quality choices and that selections should be made soon.
