### **General Discussion Items:**

Bid opening to complete maintenance and repairs on seven (7) flood control dams located in Mercer County. No bids were received. Current bidding process is closed.

Work to be done on the seven dams had been aggregated for bidding as an attempt at efficiency and possible economies of scale. Multiple contractors attended the pre-bid meeting, so we had hopes for the success of this approach. We will review the needs of each dam and prioritize them individually over the coming years. That process could attract more contractors. Logan said that Jay Russell's highest priority would be to install protective fencing for two dams.

The federal hearing is 03/09/2018 to accept or reject the PA Supreme Court map of the districts. Options include reverting to the district maps of 2011 or moving the entire primary. Mercer County is prepared for the May 15<sup>th</sup> primary as of this date.

Greenburg noted that Governor Wolf has ordered that if a county is going to change their voting system, they should acquire a system for future elections that has a paper audit trail. Greenburg said this could be a paper ballot or a machine system with an internal paper trail. Logan said as Fiscal Director he would be opposed to the changing of election machines because our current system is state-certified and produces a reliable election tally. Rather than spend \$1.2 million or more on new electronic machines, he would prefer a straight paper ballot with scanners at a cost of about \$150,000. Greenburg said that alternative systems being proposed in other states are already being challenged; any decision will be some time in the future.

Greenburg said the petition deadline passed successfully and 113 petitions were filed.

The Mercer County election office is having trouble finding poll workers for the Grove City poll site #3. Greenburg mailed a flyer to all registered voters. Grove City poll site #1 has relocated to the Mid-Western Intermediate Unit due to construction at Hillview School. No issued noted.

White met with the Dog warden to discuss how to increase sales of licenses. She reported that the hotels are in compliance with the hotel excise tax. She assisted the Convention and Visitors Bureau with a letter of explanation about the ordinance that is to be sent to Bed and Breakfast and Airbnb locations in Mercer County. Many of these locations are not aware of their hotel excise tax obligation.

Use of Courthouse Grounds approved for Indivisible Mercer County on 3/24/2018. The group is commemorating the school incident in Parkland, FL.
