ENGINEER'S REPORT

Thompson Rd. Screening Device – Still in place and appears to be working. Still some paper issues. They should be routinely cleaning the device. It has cut down on the amount of debris at the pump.

Plantation Park – We sent a letter sent to Plantation Park agreeing with their method of billing for the pump station, but we have yet to see anything from them on the bill. We put three months on one bill using our method and will continue to do it this way until we hear from someone at Plantation Park.

Municipal Wasteload Management Report – Due for the year prior. Board will review/approve at the March 13, 2017 meeting.

NPDES Permit Renewal – This is a (5) year permit and scheduled to expire 5/31/2019. All information, lab testing, etc. has to be sent to PA DEP by the end of November/2018.

*A motion was made by John Lechner and seconded by Robert Gregory to give authorization to Gannett Fleming to prepare and make application for our NPDES Permit at the cost of \$3,300.00. Motion carried unanimously.

*A motion was made by Jerry Johnson and seconded by John Lechner to give authorization for the Chairman to sign the Annual Municipal Wasteload Management Report. Motion carried unanimously.

OPERATOR'S REPORT

For the month of December/2017, everything performed within the limits of the Permit. A tour was given of the plant to (2) East Lackawannock Township Supervisors. (11) Tons of sludge was hauled out from the plant. There were no grinder pump call-outs, but a new stator was installed in one of the grinder pumps. A panel heater was installed at Countryside Nursing Home and at the Interstate Pump Station.

OLD BUSINESS

Garage Door Opener Quote – A quote was received from Doors n More for \$1560.00. A request was made to Cozad Garage Doors, Overhead Door Company and also Hoffman Garage Doors. No other quotes were received to this date. Will look at this again at the 3/13/18 meeting.

Countryside Convalescent Home - *A motion was made by John Lechner and seconded by Jerry Johnson to begin adding a monthly surcharge for the improperly shredded materials found in the well. Motion carried unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS

Application for Sewage Service – Chris Stevens/8315 Lamor Rd./Mercer, PA - *A motion was made by Robert Gregory and seconded by Dave Swartz to approve the Application for Sewage Service for Chris Stevens at 8315 Lamor Rd.; Mercer, PA. Motion carried unanimously.

Customer Issues:

1. **Daniel Mortland** – 8212 Lamor Rd./Mercer, PA – Can't get a loan to connect because of the lien. He is requesting we remove the lien. No action taken.

2. Jim & Lori Amon – 441A & 441B S. Shenango St./Mercer, PA. Per an email received, 441A - had an abandoned house that was to be torn down and they had plans to put a new home there someday. They paid the tap fee and had the grinder pump installed but don't feel they should make a monthly payment since no one is living there. We are not sure if the house is still standing or has been torn down. We will look into this further for the next meeting. **441B** – The house has made connection and they received a letter stating it has not. Paperwork crossed so it was noted that they are connected. There were various other complaints about the original construction 2+ years ago. No action taken.
