Appropriate funds from the Mercer County Unconventional Gas Well Fund for a development at Sharpsville Borough Erie Canal Riverwalk Project. Improvements include a Riverwalk trail, fishing pier access, an ADA unisex restroom, retention pond, benches and rain barrels. The project falls under the "Community Park" sub-category of Sec. 2315.a.1.5 of Act 13. The balance of funds will come from Sharpsville Borough, C2p2 Grant and donated material/labor. The total project cost is \$343,572.00. Project Leader is Mourine Rodgers. The project is expected to be completed in 2019.

DISCUSSION: The Commissioners thanked the Mercer County Visitors' Bureau for providing matching funds and for proactively partnering on many of the "Community Park" projects such as the Riverwalk development. Sharpsville Borough has expressed their appreciation. Future additions will include a new bridge in the vicinity.
