Congratulations to Frank Jannetti, Director of Public Safety, selected to receive one of the 2019 Governor's Awards for Local Government Excellence exemplifying Information Technology. The award will be presented at the Governor's Mansion, Harrisburg, on 04/10/2019.

Commissioners commented that the CAD installation project done in cooperation with Region 13 was the impetus for the award. It has generated cost savings to both Mercer County taxpayers and across the state. Thank you to Frank Jannetti for his initiative and oversight.

Elections reported that there were no ballot challenges in Mercer County. The ballot is officially set. Greenburg also advised that the PA State Senate Democrats will hold an Election Reform News Conference on 03/26/2019. Several experts/Directors of Election will be speaking to address both Voting Systems and Election Reform concerns.

Coroner Libonati reported that so far in 2019 Mercer County has 5 confirmed drug deaths, 2 deaths pending forensic review, 1 death under investigation, and 6 unclaimed bodies. He reported that <u>www.overdosefreepa.pitt.edu</u> is an excellent resource to view statistics and trends. He also commented that Mercer County tends to have an increase in drug deaths during the summer.

Commissioners commented that Lt. Governor Fetterman is coming to Penn State Sharon on 04/03/2019 as part of his "Legalization of Recreational Marijuana Listening Tour."
