DISCUSSION: Commissioners thanked the Election Director and Chief Clerk for their assistance in determining the best solution for the benefit of Mercer County residents. Current allocated reimbursement includes Help American Vote Act funds of \$118,311.82 or approximately 12% of the cost. (HAVA is 95% Federal, 5% State match). Additional reimbursement is dependent on State budget approvals. Fiscal noted that it is unnecessary to replace a system that was safe and in working condition.
