DISCUSSION: Commissioners announced that they just completed a TEFRA hearing to review the projects at Thiel College. Although there is no cost to the County, the Commissioners must hold a public hearing when refinancing is presented since they appoint the board members of Industrial Development Authority. Representatives from Thiel College summarized their two

year involvement with the Rural Community Loan Development Fund Program. Proposed projects with the re-finance include expansion and renovation of the Academic/Science/Library Complex and the Wellness Center. The Commissioners are impressed with the projects and thanked the College and MCIDA for the collaborative partnership to attract more students and to expand educational programs at the College.
