Bid opening for the Roof Top Unit(s) project at Penn State Extension Office. One bid received from Roth Mechanical, Inc. for \$70,440.00. Bid referred to Solicitor for review.

Announced the Re-organization meeting is scheduled for 1-6-2020.

Commissioners announced that the Special Election for Tedd Nesbit, 8th District, will need to be scheduled by the Speaker of the House. They are requesting that it be concurrent with the Primary on April 28th. Each party from Mercer and Butler Counties will choose a candidate. The Speaker has 10 days following receipt of Representative Nesbit's resignation to announce an election date. The announcement must be 60 days prior to the chosen date. Approximately 37 precincts in Mercer County will be impacted by the Special Election. All registered voters in the 8th District may vote in the Special Election.

Greenburg explained that an election other than on Primary day would definitely incur additional expenses from precinct rental costs to poll worker expenses. Due to Act 77, the county may not need to print 110% of the ballots as currently required because of a change in the formula. The county will still need to lease thumb drives to accommodate the Special Election. There is also a concern that voter turnout could be low if a Special Election is held independently.

The second signing of the Election Book to certify the results from the November election will be November 25, 2019.

Commissioners discussed their recent attendance at the P3 (Pennsylvania Public Private Partnership) meeting with PennDOT in Oil City to review transportation and specifically bridge issues. Despite the number of aging bridges in Mercer, the bridges are not in the worst shape. Mercer County is proactively managing replacement, renovation and repair needs.
