The grant funding for Treatment Court will expire on 2-29-20. Commissioners agree to fund the Treatment Court from the General Fund for a six-month period up to \$55,000. Other funding sources including AOPC, the Mercer County Bar Association and possible PCCD or community grants may be available during that period. Commissioners noted that overdoses have dropped in the county, and there is improvement in the 2019 numbers.

Commissioners announced that Mercer County is not applying for the Human Service Block Grant FY 2020-2021. A County match of 5% is required and services are already provided by Behavioral Health Commission, a separate entity in Mercer County. Since Mercer County is not part of the HSBG, we can participate in regional projects such as the nine county Forensic Bed initiative.

Commissioners recognized February as Black History Month and a celebration of African-American heritage.

Elections announced that ballots for the Special Election should be available next week. The process to request absentee ballots is per the old guidelines for the March 17th election. No excuse absentee ballots will not be in place until the April 28th primary election. The precincts and poll workers are ready for the Special Election.

Commissioners asked about updates with election equipment vendor, ES&S. PA Secretary of State has asked all counties to not implement upgrades to precinct scanners until they have more information about the proposed changes by the vendor. This may impact the use of precinct scanners for the March 17th election and possibly the primary. Greenburg said that high-speed scanners would be used, if necessary, to count ballots centrally.

The Iowa Caucus was discussed including delays in reporting results. It is managed by the Democratic Party and is not governed by state or local election officials. Greenburg agreed that 100 percent of the results will not be reported on election night in the future in Pennsylvania

due to legislative changes in the voting process with the new paper-based system and the passage of Act 77.
