General Discussion Items: See Below.

Chief Clerk announced the purchase of batteries for an emergency road sign installed by Grove City Hospital is per Emergency Declaration guidelines. Competitive quotes were not gathered at the time of purchase. As a safety concern the sign needed to be operational as quickly as possible, to direct traffic across a busy highway.

Controller Amundsen will research IRS guidelines for mileage reimbursement for employees who are teleworking from home. Some employees have requested reimbursement for travel from home to county worksites.

Treasurer White asked about compliance with the Secretary of Health's Order mandating masks in the worksite as of April 19th. Commissioners noted the recent purchase of 6,000 masks that are being distributed to employees and visitors to the courthouse. The Commissioners directed the Chief Clerk to issue a countywide notice to all employees to wear masks at all county offices or buildings.

Elections reported the final reimbursement in the amount of \$45,605.03 for the Special Election was submitted to Harrisburg.

Several of the precincts (45 of 46 locations, to date) have responded favorably that they will have available poll workers for the June 2nd Primary Election. 65 of the polling sites have also responded favorably that they will participate in the Primary Election.

The State will provide precinct protection kits for poll workers. It is unclear if masks will be provided for voters. No determination has been made about an "all mail" Primary. Mailing and printing costs will increase significantly if ballots are to be sent to all voters in the county. Certain vote centers may need to open to provide access per ADA compliance.
