General Discussion Items: See Below.

Commissioners announced that they attended the annual County Commissioners Association of Pennsylvania (CCAP) convention. It was very productive and was the first in-person event in over a year. Discussions included development of new technologies for rural broadband including low flying satellites. This is a unique and new option. Current demonstrations are based on small census tract samplings. More information is forthcoming, and the technology may be introduced to Mercer County in the future. The Commissioners continue to pursue all options for prospective funding to support the expansion of broadband services.

Additional presentations at the conference included discussions to replace the "gasoline tax." It is a complex problem. One of the impact areas is to look at reducing the costs of the design phase for bridges so more funding could be committed to bridge repair and replacement.

CCAP hosted a session on solar energy. Mercer County has the largest number of active permits among the counties in Pennsylvania. Eighteen (18) permits are active and fourteen (14) permits will be resubmitted for review. Participation in the state program "Clean and Green" is not beneficial to landowners in Mercer County because we use 1970 land values for real estate tax purposes, which allows leases for solar farms to be negotiated at a lower price.
