It was announced that the next Commissioners' Meeting is scheduled for July 28th.

Fiscal Administrator Logan introduced Lee Ann Nucerino, the new Fiscal Administrator for the County. He shall continue to work with her until his retirement date in January 2023. She is a qualified and welcome addition to the Fiscal Department.

Commissioners highlighted Resolution 2022-338 concerning the expansion of Broadband in Mercer County. Initially No Limits Broadband (NLB) had started the project with the completion of ten (10) towers. Now NLB has been merged with AirWave Technologies, LLC (AirWave). The new company is expanding the infrastructure, building redundancies to address power outages, and reinforcing service to customers. The newly merged company has 213 subscribers at this time, and they are working to add new customers. AirWave will continue to provide access to rural communities through investments by the company and by the County.

In addition to meeting the needs of residential customers, Commissioners highlighted that Greenville Reynolds Industrial Development Park is working with Zito to provide fiber optics for commercial clients. All the enhancements to Broadband strengthen the economy and benefit the residents, visitors, and businesses of the County.
