General Discussion Items: See Below.

Commissioners announced that efforts of the PA General Assembly resulted in increasing the budgets of Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture (PDA) by \$6.8 million. By including an increase in the state budget for conservation districts, the PA General Assembly is investing in the conservation district mission of clean water and healthy soil for all Pennsylvanians.

The Mercer County Conservation District received an increase in funding to the Conservation District Fund Allocation Program for FY 2022-2023. The FY 2021-2022 allocation was \$84,866.00 and the FY 2022-2023 allocation is \$209,140.00.

The Conservation District Fund Allocation Program provides funding each year to support the cost of Conservation District staffing and administrative assistance for conservation programing. This year's increase of \$124,274.00 will allow the District to offset county budget funds and increase the ability of the District to use other funds to support local conservation projects.

The Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP 2.0) updates on processing of eviction notice applications will be sent to the five Municipal District Judges in Mercer County. The program has maintained the cap on late fees of \$25.00 per month. This is the same as the established guidelines for ERAP 1.0. Certain Eviction Court Orders list a higher amount for tenant late fees for non-payment of rent.

Treasurer White thanked the Employee Activity Committee for hosting "Hot Dog Days" for the benefit of County employees. It is always appreciated when employees are able to gather together.
