The scope continues preparations for demolition and includes potential cul-de-sacs and final right-of-way plan development.

Supplement \$135,665.61 of additional services to the current Engineering Agreement No. 010P96 for the Ohl Street bridge project. The scope provides environmental tasks to move through the NEPA process, an ATON plan, a public meeting and structure removal sequence plans.

The total engineering agreement amount is now \$755,457.51. The Reimbursement Agreement No. R21010007 will also be adjusted to accommodate these changes. These project costs are 100% reimbursable (80% federal funds plus 20% state funds).
