### **ENGINEER'S REPORT**

Countryside Estates – Jim and Dan discussed the Authority sending Countryside Estates Director in Butler, a letter that they now own the grinder pumps because of their lack of cooperation with the discharge and not heeding to the Authority's directions, they can own them from now on. \*A motion was made by Dale Bestwick and seconded by Clifford Hughes to send a letter to Countryside Estates as described above. Motion carried unanimously. Dan will put together the letter.

Plantation Park - They had some really high flows last year. They are balancing out at 53 edu's.

The NPDES Permit Renewal is due at the end of the month. Pat will sign the application.

Wasteload Management Report is done and was submitted to PA DEP.

**Thompson Rd. Pumpstation** — We had some freezing issues last month. Dan stated that one of the problems was that the water pressure increased a lot. No one seems to know why. Dan is suggesting they put on a pressure reducing valve. We received a quote from Pennwest Specialized Services in the amount of \$833.93 for the work on the valve. Dan received a list of rates from Pennwest for different services offered. \*A motion was made by Dave Swartz and seconded by Clifford Hughes to approve the quote of \$833.93, #2237.3 for the placement of a pressure reducing valve by Pennwest Specialized Services at the Thompson Rd. Pumpstation. Motion carried unanimously.

# **OPERATOR'S REPORT**

The flow meter was online for the month. 65,000/gal/day.

Everything operated within the permit limits for the month of December/2023.

Our NPDES Permit expires at the end of August 2024. The renewal application is almost complete. Just waiting on lab results.
