

**PUBLIC NOTICE - MERCER COUNTY  
2020 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG)  
APPLICATION**

Act 179 of 1974 of the Pennsylvania Legislature, entitled the Community Development Block Grant Program, establishes annual block grant entitlements Cities, Boroughs, and Towns and Townships. Mercer County is making application for a \$732,901 grant from the 2020 CDBG program from the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development.

Mercer County intends to use their FY 2020 funds to undertake housing rehabilitation and/or sewer improvements, Grove City Borough sewer/water improvements (McConnell Street) and removal of architectural barriers (sidewalk curb cuts), Greenville Borough housing rehabilitation, demolition/clearance and code enforcement, Sharpsville Borough removal of architectural barriers (sidewalk curb cuts) and Pine Township housing rehabilitation and public facilities/senior center.

The **SECOND VIRTUAL PUBLIC HEARING** will be held on MONDAY, OCTOBER 5th at 5:00PM to obtain citizen input on the 2020 CDBG Program and Three-Year Community Development Plan.

At least 70% of the total grant funds will benefit LMI persons. Mercer County has adopted a Fair Housing Resolution, appointed a Fair Housing Officer and adopted MBE/WBE and Section 504 Plans.
