General Discussion Items: See Below.

Commissioners read a statement from Public Safety concerning access to vaccines in Mercer County:

"The leadership of our local health care institutions, the Mercer County Department of Public Safety and other organizations are in constant contact and are developing plans for mass vaccination sites for whenever vaccines become available in quantities that would warrant such an event. We are encouraging citizens to remain patient as the number of vaccines we have available are not sufficient to run a clinic at this time. As the Department of Health releases additional vaccines, the group will announce the location and times that clinics will be established. At this point, the Pennsylvania Department of Health is advising that individuals that are classified as Phase 1A are the only people that can obtain vaccines. As further Phases are released, we will continue to work with those classifications, and eventually to the general public, to offer the vaccines in the most efficient and effective manner we can.

We are also aware that certain pharmacies already have vaccines and are offering them with various methods of signing up for individuals. If citizens that are classified as Phase 1A want to utilize that method, and the pharmacies are able to deliver the vaccines to you, we support that method as well."

Commissioners noted the critical need for vaccines and that the County is subject to the mandates of PA Department of Health, which manages distribution. They encouraged residents to access all available resources to schedule vaccination appointments.

Elections/Voter Registration announced the mailing of a notice to 13,798 registered voters who selected to be on the annual mail-in/absentee voting list. Per statute, an annual mailing is required to be sent to people who checked box 7 on the mail-in form to ask if they want to receive a mail-in ballot for the coming year.

Elections/Voter Registration also reported that the resident who questioned a provisional ballot, at a previous public meeting, met with the Voter Registration staff and was satisfied that he had completed a request form. His questions were asked and answered.

Treasurer White reported the successful conversion to PALS 2.0 software for hunting licensing. She also reported that registrations for dog licenses have increased 46% and dog license revenues have increased 48%. This is due an upgrade in the software. The printed form now prefills the dog and owner information on the license application.
