**Public Comment:** Residents from Jefferson Township including Ryan Gassner, Randy Carnino and Margaret Shelley expressed concern about the proposed development of solar farms in Jefferson Township, zoned R-2. Citizens commented that across the country several solar farms have been abandoned after the expiry of Federal subsidies. The life expectancy of the panels is ten (10) years, and they are often installed without footers. Concerned citizens stated that this type of installation may lead to airborne hazards and other risks such as leeching cadmium. Contracts for land use typically require the landowner to be responsible for any clean-up or restoration.

Although the Commissioners are not responsible for zoning, the group requested that they share information with other Mercer County Elected Officials in hopes of strengthening municipal zoning requirements and enforcement efforts.

The Commissioners acknowledged their concerns and suggested the group contact Mercer County Regional Planning Commission, the Conservation District and Penn State Extension. These agencies are involved with local development and assist in educating the agricultural community about contracts and proposed development of farmland.

**Questions of the Media:** Topics discussed included repeal of the Emergency Declaration due to COVID-19 and the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP). Questions asked and answered.
