#### **General Discussion Items:** See Below.

Use of Courthouse Grounds application by the Mercer County Central Labor Council to host the Workers Memorial Service on April 29, 2022, in the Rotunda of the Courthouse was approved.

Use of Courthouse Grounds application by Kingdom Unification to host the National Day of Prayer – Mercer County event on May 5, 2022, was approved subject to receipt of insurance certificate listing Mercer County as additional insured. Request is to use the Bandstand, Courthouse steps or Rotunda, if there is inclement weather.

Commissioners reported that an old tunnel on Route 62, east of Mercer is not designed for today's safety and transportation requirements and has steadily deteriorated over the years to become a hazard to motorists. It is owned by Canadian National Railroad.

Through conversations with Congressman Kelly's office, replacement of the tunnel was identified as being eligible for funding through the "Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act." Congressman Kelly may submit up to 15 projects annually from his district to the U. S. House Committee on Appropriations. As part of the submission file, the Commissioners wrote a letter of support for the Community Project Funding request. This is the first step in soliciting funding.

A request was made for \$10MM. Based on a PennDOT study from 2020, the estimated replacement cost is \$12MM. Funding of the project may be a powerful incentive to Canadian National Railroad to replace the tunnel and to support the economic development of Mercer County. It will take coordination among many entities to successfully complete the project.

Following additional review of the building, the Commissioners announced that they will move forward with the initial engineering design of an ADA compliant passenger elevator at the 107 North Diamond Street property.

Commissioners announced that Airwave Technology has executed a purchase agreement to acquire No Limits Broadband. They will assume ownership of the equipment, tower leases and

are transitioning customers to Airwave Technology. The company is well positioned to provide internet services, and they have recently added eight (8) new customers since the acquisition.

Commissioners announced the reopening of McKeever Environmental Learning Center. Four years after the center closed due to a lack of funds for its operation, the learning center in Lake Township is being reopened to serve as a regional teaching center about nature. State authorities will hold a meeting to hear public input for the reopening at 6 p.m. Thursday at Emmanuel Christian Church, 4495 Greenville Sandy Lake Road, Stoneboro.
